**Vision:**

**Aims:**

Our curriculum will ignite curiosity, inspire a love of learning and build knowledge and skills. We will recognise the uniqueness of our pupils and put their well-being at the heart of all that we do. We will nurture and develop individual abilities and talents to enable our pupils to achieve.

We will be sharing this with the children through an assembly, class discussions and a display board in the corridor.

**Curriculum:**

In order to deliver this vision effectively, we are undergoing a period of curriculum review. We are working alongside an experienced curriculum consultant who is supporting us to develop a curriculum that reflects the unique character and community of The Croft. The staff are currently mapping out the details of this new curriculum which incorporates the statutory requirements of the National Curriculum and additional skills to enable the children to become resilient, compassionate and responsible citizens.

**Our Curriculum Intent:**

- We want our curriculum to ignite curiosity, inspire a love of learning and build knowledge and skills.
- Our children will explore global themes through an enquiry-based curriculum. Their enquiries will lead to a product. This product will showcase their learning skills and nurture a sense of pride.
- English will be the thread that knits our curriculum together. Every class will develop their enquiries around high quality core texts. Wider reading will enrich their enquiries. Writing will communicate what we want to say to our school, our locality, our nation and the world.

We will be piloting the enquiry curriculum in two phases; two classes in Term 4 and all other classes during the summer terms. We will be inviting you to a curriculum evening in Term 6 where we will share further details with you and showcase the products created by the children in Term 5.
